Schedule of Classes for Friday, August 4, 2023

Friday 10:00am-12 noon Chip Carving for Beginners

Presented by Rick Bartels from Wisconsin. Rick will provide a background in chip carving basic techniques and safety. You will be able to practice the basic skills on a project that you will then take home with you. Knives, wood and a carving glove will be provided—all you need to bring is an eagerness to learn!

Friday 11:30am-1:00pm Scroll Saw Basics

Presented by Tom Taylor from Ohio. Tom will discuss blade selection for various projects and wood types. He will include information on spiral and straight blades and when each one is best suited for a particular purpose. He will give basic information on scroll saws as well as talk about applying patterns to wood and how to get started cutting. He will also address the ethics of using patterns and how copyright rules work.
