We are seeking vendors who can offer any type of hand or power tools, finishing supplies and equipment, hardware, fasteners, decorative products, air filtration systems, patterns, books, clock parts, lumber, and any other products and materials that can be used to help folks make their own handmade projects. Customers appreciate being able to see the products up close, ask questions, see demonstrations and talk to a real live person rather than just read product info on their computer screens. This is a chance to connect face to face with customers which is a great benefit to both the business and the customers!

Food is available on-site during the show. Friday evening we host a dinner gathering for attendees and the vendors. This is a popular event and provides all of us a way to get to know each other better. An RSVP is appreciated and details on the dinner will be posted on the website as they are finalized.
