Friday 9:30 am -11:00 am - Introduction to Intarsia

Presented by Crystal Moore

Learn how individual pieces of wood come together to paint a picture and create stunning dimensional art. Crystal will cover core techniques including pattern prep, cutting tips, basic shaping, gluing up and finishing methods for intarsia pieces. This class will be a great place for people interested in learning how to get started with the art of Intarsia.

Join Tony for some epoxy and wood fun! Tony is an expert and core teaching staff member at Woodcraft of Iowa City and his charcuterie class is one of the most popular classes there. Tony will pass on detailed tips on how to accurately measure epoxy for irregular shapes, how to pour to reduce bubbling, and how to finish the board.

He'll also give suggestions for finding sources for Corian and will provide information on cutting non-ferrous metals such as brass and aluminum.

Saturday 9:30 am - 11:00 am - Wooden Gear Clocks

Presented by Dave Kettunen.

A class designed for experienced scroll sawyers. It is very detail oriented and will go through the steps of making and getting a wooden gear clock running. It will involve showing pattern parts as Dave works through his process of cutting and building the clock. He will use show and tell examples to show you specific details. A Clayton Boyer #6 pattern design will be used as the example for this class. Some students might like to have a copy of the pattern to follow along in class and perhaps add notes to the pattern as he discusses the process – then, take that pattern home to build your own clock. Dave can provide a pattern, for those who are interested, which will require a separate materials fee in addition to the class fee. The pattern will only be available to those who pre-register for the class.
